Terms and conditions of purchase

- 2. FutureSynthesis sp. z o.o. sells goods and services via:

- 3. The Company's scope of business includes the design, synthesis and purification of nucleic acids according to individual customer orders. Accordingly, it is not possible to withdraw from the sales contract after accepting the terms of the offer and placing the order.
- 4. Each order should include:
 - 1. the names of the products with the sequence ordered, the quantity/scale of synthesis ordered, and the method of purification.
 - 2. name of the ordering person, contact phone number
 - 3. the exact name, address and tax ID number of the ordering institution and the delivery address.
- 5. All valuations of goods on the website and in the offer are given in Polish zloty and do not include VAT.
- 6. Each order placed is confirmed by us in writing (by e-mail) stating the order number and the completion date. Confirmation of the order signifies its acceptance for execution, and thus the conclusion of the Sales Agreement between FutureSynthesis sp. z o.o. ("FS") and the customer. Complaint is considered on the basis of comparison of the material of a given sample in the possession of FS and sent by the customer. Compatibility analysis is performed by HPLC, PAGE or MALDI mass analysis. Complaints relating to material that has already been mixed with other reactants are not considered. Demonstration of product defects is carried out by HPLC, PAGE or MALDI mass analysis.

If the complaint is accepted, the defective goods will be repaired or replaced with other, full-quality goods. If

this is not possible (for example, due to the lack of components of the product), FutureSynthesis will return to the Customer the equivalent of the price of the goods or offer him other available goods of his choice. Collection of the complained product from the Customer is carried out at the expense of FutureSynthesis sp. z o. o. and only by a courier ordered by the company.

FS does not accept returns of purchased goods that have not been the subject of complaint. Synthesized nucleic acids may contain traces of other components and complaints are not accepted on this account.

12. Personal data:
